Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Closure of: Cross Lane (Part), Marlborough (Ref: TTRO 6568)

Notice is hereby given that Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

Cross Lane (Part), Marlborough; from its junction with Cardigan Road for a distance of approximately 40 metres in a northerly direction.

To enable: Thames Water to carry out a service pipe repair.

Alternative routes: via Cross Lane (unaffected length) – Hyde Lane - Cardigan and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This Order will come into operation on 03 June 2020 and it is anticipated that the closure will be required until 05 June 2020. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.









