M4 J15 Advance warning of overnight closures

National Highways operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A roads. We are currently on track to complete major works to this junction by Friday 15 October. Please see below advance notification of our last planned overnight closures.

29 September - 8pm to 6am

West side of roundabout closed including west side slip roads. There will be no access from the A346 northbound onto M4 J15 and the eastbound off slip and westbound on slip will be closed.

30 September and 1 October - 8pm to 6am

East side of roundabout closed including east side slip roads. There will be no access from the A419 southbound onto M4 J15 and the eastbound on slip and westbound off slip will be closed.

The A419 southbound will be closed between Commonhead roundabout and M4 J15.

19 and 20 October - 8pm to 6am

M4 J15 eastbound off slip will be closed for resurfacing.
