Our website at <https://www.marlborough-tc.gov.uk> is published in-house by Marlborough Town Council and we want it to be accessible to everyone.

CHANGE THE APPEARANCE, LISTEN TO AND NAVIGATE OUR WEBSITE USING A KEYBOARD

We have added a screen reader so that you can:

- change colours, contrast levels and text size and spacing
- zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- switch to a dyslexic font
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- listen to most of the website using our screen reader, or one of your own

For universal keyboard commands for any Windows browser, as well as all the options outlined above in our screen reader, go to page 3.

HOW ACCESSIBLE IS THIS WEBSITE?

Our website contains some pages or certain other elements which we know are not fully accessible:

ACCESSIBILITY: NAVIGATE OUR WEBSITE USING A KEYBOARD

UNIVERSAL KEYBOARD COMMANDS - USING ANY WINDOWS BROWSER

These commands apply to any website (but may vary depending on your operating system)

Open a website: Ctrl+L (or F6) places the focus in the web browser's address bar. Enter the domain, e.g. www.google.com and press Enter

Read a website: to scroll the viewport up, down, left or right use the arrow keys

Use Tab to move forward from one item such as a menu option to the next

Use Shift+Tab to move backwards between items

Use Enter to activate a link or a button

Use Space to toggle an element's state (for example a checkbox)

Use arrow keys to change the value of an item (for example on a slider menu or to change numerical values)

Use Esc to cancel a prompt or close elements such as a dialogue box

Use Ctrl+ to increase the size of the display (text and images)

Use Ctrl- to decrease the size of the display (text and images)

SCREENREADER

To make our website even more accessible we've added a screenreader. The menu looks like this:

The screen reader is located at the bottom right corner of the website.

Instead of using a mouse to press the buttons you can use:

Alt+Shift+L to open or minimise the screenreader menu

Alt+Shift+P to play an audio version of an item where available or for a user-highlighted block of text

Alt+Shift+E to pause the audio reader

Alt+Shift+S to stop the audio reader

Alt+Shift+O to increase the font size multiple times

Alt+Shift+U to decrease the font size multiple times

Alt+Shift+R to reset the font size

Alt+Shift+M to increase text spacing

Alt+Shift+N to decrease text spacing

Alt+Shift+J to toggle Dyslexic font on and off

Alt+Shift+G to toggle grey tones on and off

There are three high contrast display options:

Alt+Shift+H to toggle high contrast option 1 on and off

Alt+Shift+J to toggle high contrast option 2 on and off

Alt+Shift+K to toggle high contrast option 3 on and off
