Most of the ground works and excavations are completed so you should notice a reduction in the number of large trucks in and out of the estate.

The first piling works have been completed, with the next set due to start week commencing 9 August and to last for around 10 days. We used a sound dampener during the first set of works to help reduce the noise for local residents and plan to use this for future works.

Work is also starting on the public open spaces, as well as the show homes, and we will keep you updated on progress.
